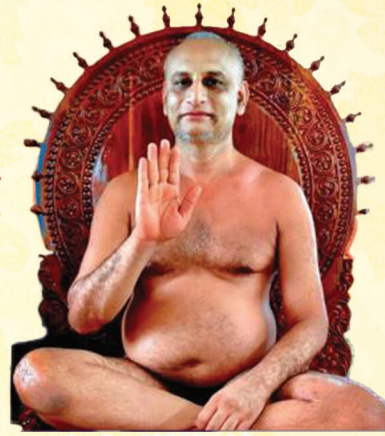

Dear Relatives,

In the tradition of divine and sacred temples (kshetra) in India, 'Karkala' has been considered as one of most famous of all temples. As we know, Karkala Kshetra, including Moodabidri, is regarded as 'JainaKashi', which is the centre of millions of devotees. Karkala is an abode of 18 Jina Mandiras. Centre for Hiriyangadi Bha Sri Neminatha Swamy's Hirebasadi, our proud national historical monument 'Unnatha Manstambha' and the world famous Baghawan Bahubali Swamy's 42 feet height monument built with one rock structure are also found in Karkala. All these are really the 'mahabhagyas' for the Jain community. Karkala as a 'PunyaKshetra' was also the kingdom for the famous Bairavaras. The 'Kshetra' has acquired the spiritual power and it is now the most sacred for the Jains. Once upon a time, it was a great centre of beautiful palace. Today, this sacred land is shining with 'gurumathas', 'ashramas' imparting culture and values and a great centre of famous Jain educational institutions.

This 'PunyaKshetra' is also the famous world tourist centre and it has two 'Chaturmukha' Basadis. These two Basadis are unique 'Jinalayas' (Jain Temples) and it has been an attractive spiritual centre for localites and devotees from outside. Added to this, it is located on the side of the highways and it is surrounded by vast and beautiful lake. Amidst it, the 'Anekere Chaturmukha Basadi' can be easily seen by all. These 'Basadis' represent the status and prestige of the Jains. Unfortunately, these 'Basadis' were in a totally dilapidated condition. We are, indeed, aware of it. Currently, an earnest effort has been made to renovate it beautifully and this spiritual commitment has been started yielding fruits with the progress of the speedy work.

In the heart of the Karkala town, with 26 acres of land, the shining 'Anekere', the lake' was built with a twin purpose; to provide water to provide drinking water and to take bath of the elephants of 'Bairavaras'. Along with the construction of 'Anekere', the Pandyanatha Pandyappodaya, a clan of the Bairavarasa founded the Chaturmukha Kere (Lake) Basadi. In these Basadis, Bha Adinatha Swamy, Bha Sri Chandranatha Swamy, Bha Sri Shanthinatha Swamy, Bha Sri Mahaveera Swamy has been traditionally worshipped, along with the east facing higher strata of worship of Bha Sri Parshwanatha Swamy and Mahamathe Sri Pdmavathi Swamy. In the divine presence of seers and elders, 'stalaprashne' revealed that the performance of renovation and 'punarprathiste' would help this 'kshetra' to gain lot of popularity. We strongly believe that the renovation of this unique beautiful 'vastu' structured 'KereBasadi Kshetra' will certainly enhance the respect of the Jain community. By keeping this in mind and with the cooperation of all, we are committed to its completion as early as possible. It is learnt that this 'KereBasadi' was in the possession of the King 5000 years ago, in the divine presence and guidance of most revered Digambara Muni Maharaja, the 'Kere Basadi' was sacredly worshipped.

Therefore, every work being constructed in this 'Kshetra', we consider it as the result of the divine blessings of so many revered 'Munishrees', who paid a visit to this 'Basad' at different times.

This has encouraged us to move forward with the divine work. Added to this, it is our divine fortune that with the divine blessings and special interest of two Munishrees Pa. Pu. 108 Munishree Amogha Keerthi Maharaaj and Pa. Pu. Munishree Amara Keerthi Maharaaj, we got the guidance and support to complete the renovation of 'KereBasadi' with total 'shilamaya'.

Already the work of the beautiful outer wall of the 'Basadi' has been started along, with the 'shilamaya' of the traditional 'vastu shilpa' sculpture being restored.

The complete 'shilamaya' of the 'Chaturmukha KereBasadi' is in progress. In the divine presence of Karkala Jaina Mathadeesha Rajaguru Dhyanayogi Swasti Sri Lalitha Battaraka Pattaacharyavarya and under the leadership and guidance of PadmaVibhushana Rajashree Dr. Veerendra Heggade, and the President of the Basadi Renovation Committee Dr. Rajendra Kumar, the Working President, and the Honorary Advisor, Sri Jaina Dharma Renovation Committee Shri K Rathnakar Raj, Arasu Kinyakka Ballal, Padubidre Beedu, Shri K Abhayachandra Jain, Moodabidri, Shri M. K. Vijayakumar, as Chief Secretary along with Sri Jaina Dharma Renovation Sangha (R), Karkala, the Vastu expert, Shri Moodabidre Sudarshan Indra and the cooperation of the community people, we are committed to renovate and beautify the 'KereBasadi'.
